

Forth Region Funday 2019

Thank you very much for registering to come along to the Forth Region Funday 2019. The following document will provide you all of the details you need to know for this year's event.

Applications

A reminder that applications are now live for this year's event. The cost per participant (including siblings) for activities will be £10.

Applications will only be accepted once payment is made, therefore it is essential that you clarify numbers before booking. This booking must include all adult numbers as a condition of booking is that they will assist with activities. You may request a small number to stay onsite or help with younger sections.

All groups must provide and run a base (details to be provided on the application).

The deadline for applications is Sunday 31st March or when the cap of 800 YP is reached.

All payments are final and will not be refunded, you may book in additional numbers before the deadline providing the cap hasn't been reached.

Camping

If you wish to camp at the event this year, you must book into the Barrwood as normal. Please make sure you do this in plenty time before the event.

Campsite allocations will be issued to groups in the week leading up to the Funday at the latest.

For those camping over the weekend, registration will occur at the leaders meeting at the Barn at 8.30pm on the Friday night. A representative from every group (those camping) must be present to ensure you receive all the relevant details for the weekend as well as your registration packs.

For groups arriving on the Saturday, you will register at the main gate on arrival.

Day Visitors

Please note that if you are only coming to the Funday for the Saturday, you are still required to book into the Barrwood.

Groups visiting for the day may pitch small gazebo's or similar on Windy Ridge (up the stairs and to the left) to use as a base.

Visitors can arrive from 9am and must be offsite by 10pm.

All visitors must park in the field unless closer parking is required due to mobility issues.

On arrival, all visitors must register at the main gate to receive a visitor's wristband.

Please note that the set afternoon lunchtime is for activity staff only and no activities will be running. Groups can have lunch at any point in the day.

At this year's event, we have some new and exciting activities on offer as well as the return of some old favourites!

The format for this year will be open, where the young people are welcome to wander between the activities during the day.

Some of the more popular activities will run as banded sessions to ensure we limit any queuing. These bands will provide you entry to the activity at a set time and without this you won't be able to take part.

Banded Activities

- Water Inflatables (No non-swimmers)
- Water Boats
- Nerf Battle
- BB Target Shooting
- Laser Tag
- Tomahawk Throwing
- Junior Fencing (Beavers & Cubs)
- Fencing (Scouts & Explorers)
- Zorb Raceway

You can request bands on the application form. You will receive notification of what bands you have been allocated prior to the event to allow you to work out the distribution of bands to your young people.

Only request the number of bands that you need rather than the same number as the attendance.

Please note that places are limited on these activities, so you may not be allocated all the places that you ask for!

Bands will be handed out when you register at Funday.

Groups are responsible for ensuring that any parental permission required for activities is obtained prior to Funday.

Parking

There will be no access to the bottom car park for any vehicles other than those carrying group equipment or food. We would ask that you limit the number of cars that this is spread between to prevent congestion. Those vehicles containing kit and food will be directed to a drop off location where they can unload. After unloading, these vehicles must be moved to the field. No vehicles can be left in either turning circle.

Trailers can be parked in the bottom car park with guidance from the parking marshals.

Young people and their rucksacks must be dropped off in the field and walk up from there.

Water and Waste

We would like to ask all groups to please ensure that both their young people and visitors are reminded to bring plenty of drinking water with them as there will be high demand on the taps over a hot weekend.

Please remember that your waste must be dealt with by your group after the weekend- there is no provision for waste collection.
