Subject to there being a manageable number of applications, it is expected that all applicants will be invited to a local week-end selection event starting and/or finishing at The Craigs or The Barrwood on 25/11-26/11/2017 and including an overnight indoor sleep-over locally. There will be a small charge to cover costs. It is essential to attend this one-time event to be considered for selection. Confirmation and joining instructions will be sent to your contact e-mail(s) by 21st November. There will be more information at the end of the selection event. If your daughter/son is then offered a place you may decide to accept it or not.

Should your son/daughter not be successful in gaining a place on WSJ24 then please maintain their interest in Scouting. There is usually interest from many applicants and places in the Unit are usually over-subscribed. The selection is neither a test of their Scouting skills nor a judgement on them as individuals. Selection is to create a team from all the eligible age year groups who can individually benefit and collectively work together. Equally attending WSJ24 is not an end in itself to Scouting value. Please make it clear to all applicants that Scouting will continue to offer a fully worthwhile sectional programme to meet their needs through to age 25 and that other future International opportunities will always be available to all members.
