## Terrain 2 Hillwalking (Summer) - Training

**WHEN:** Friday 5th September start at 5pm, finish Sunday 7th September at 4pm

**NOTE:** Pre-meet - conducted online, 31<sup>st</sup> August 5.30pm - 8pm (Online)

**WHERE:** Meggernie Scout Centre

**COST:** £150 - non-refundable

**DESCRIPTION:**

Forth Region are offering a Summer Hillwalking Terrain 2 training course that is suitable for those wishing to acquire their Adventurous Activity Permit for Hillwalking. This residential course covers all major practical aspects of the syllabus such as poor visibility navigation, security on steep/exposed ground and emergency procedures.

This course is also open to existing permit holders, those working towards a permit or wishing to refresh skills. It is also suitable for anyone wishing to develop their experience but who may not wish to acquire a permit at this time.

The course will be based at Meggernie Scout Centre, includes indoor accommodation and is fully catered. Places are limited and are allocated on a first come first served basis.

All attendees are also required to attend a pre-meet (online) on the 31st August, 5.30pm – 8pm.

**PRE-REQUISITES:** Each candidate to be suitable for training should meet at least ONE of the following three criteria:

- have successfully completed terrain 1 training/assessment OR
- have completed training or the NGB Hill & Moorland Leader Award) OR
- confident with all aspects of the Terrain 1 syllabus and possess a reasonable amount of experience operating within terrain 1 areas (i.e. relevant hillwalking experience)

All candidates must:

be comfortable operating on the hills in poor weather conditions including poor visibility and at night, over rough/rugged/steep terrain and away from marked routes or paths, of a good level of fitness to be able to partake in a full days hill/mountain walk over rough/rugged/steep terrain.
